



## FOUNDATION GRANTS

The Indian Nations Presbytery Foundation invites application for grant monies from churches and new ministry projects which comply with the purposes of the Foundation as authorized by Indian Nations Presbytery. These purposes are outlined in the Foundation's by-laws and state, in part:

*...to raise monies about the normal budgetary process..., to meet the future needs of the Presbytery. Such needs include start-up monies for new missions for such needs for church plant repairs, modifications, and Building Codes through grants.*

### Application Process

Applications for grants will be considered in April and must be submitted to the presbytery office no later than **April 1, 2026**. The presbytery office is located at:

The application should include:

1. Name of the church or ministry project.
2. A brief description of the purpose for which the funds are requested.
3. The amount of funds requested (this must be completed).
4. Confirmation that the Session, Board or Commission of the submitting organization approves of the request and the purposes for which it is intended.

All grant applications should be typewritten and should not exceed two pages. All applications must be complete. **If an application has blank areas it will be returned.**

Matching grants will receive strong consideration because the Foundation believes such funding formulas maximize its grant dollars, and years churches have contributed to presbytery budget. Most important is how much your church expects to contribute toward the project, either in financial support and/or in-kind services. If the grant will be matched by an outside source after the grant has been awarded, indicate on application.

Recipients of Foundation grants will be asked to submit follow-up reports to the Foundation prior to each presbytery meeting and after completion of the project for which the grant was intended. This report should outline the current status, the results of the project and the ways in which money was used to accomplish those results.
