 Let us confess our sin.

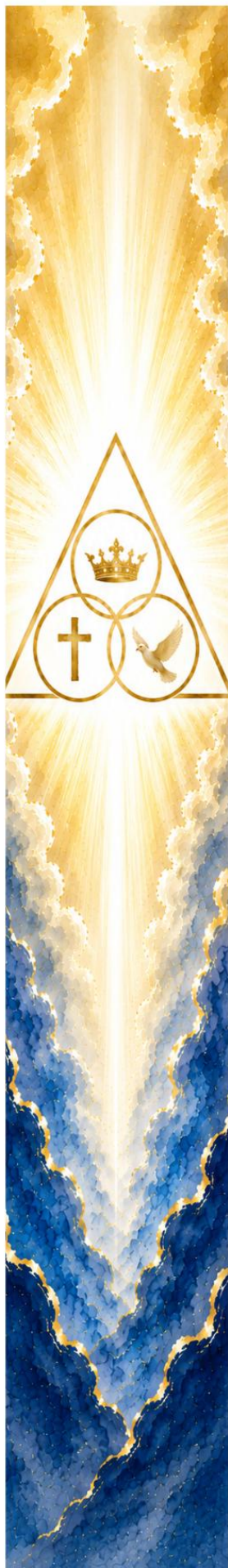
Prayer of Confession

Affirmation of Faith (*Apostles' Creed*)

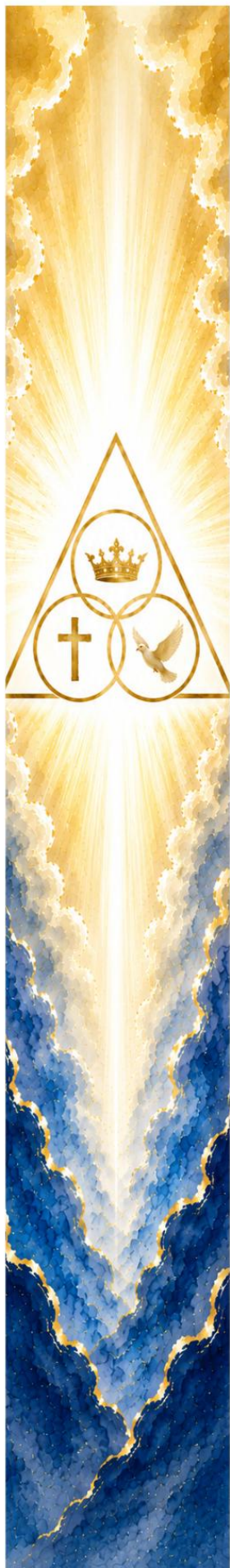
**I believe in God, the Father almighty,

 Teaching and serving in Christ's name.

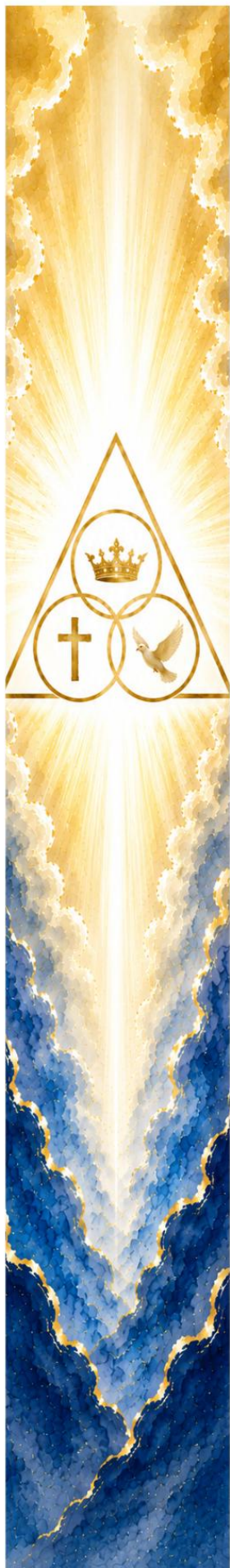
We pray for places of conflict and division,

 That we may live faithfully as your people.

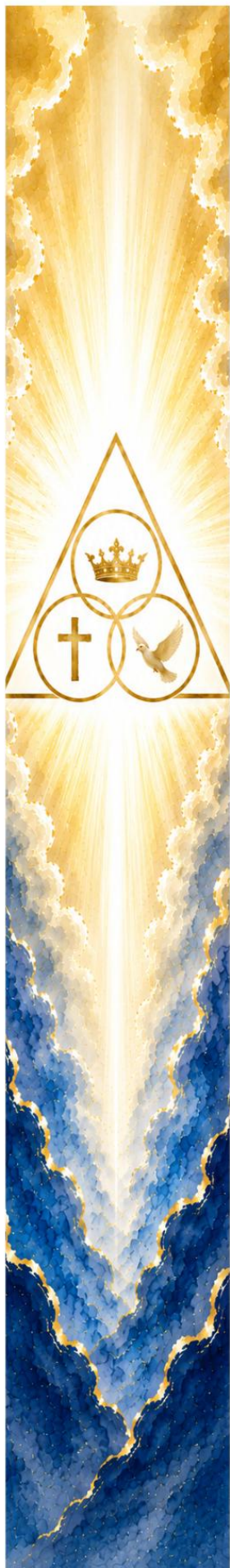
We pray all this in the name of the Father,
