Special Offerings and other Special Gifts

The four special offerings of the PC(USA):

One Great Hour of Sharing (Palm Sunday/Easter). This offering enables the church to share God's love with our neighbors-in-need around the world by providing relief to those affected by natural disasters, food to the hungry, and helping empower the poor and oppressed. **(March 24 and March 31, 2024)**

Pentecost Offering (Pentecost Sunday) nurtures the faith of youth/young adults. Congregations are encouraged to keep 40% of this offering; the remaining 60% sent to presbytery is GA's share for children at risk, youth and young adult ministries. **(May 19, 2024)**

Peace & Global Witness Offering (World Communion Sunday) gifts enable the church to promote the Peace of Christ by addressing systems of injustice across the world. Congregations are encouraged to keep up to 25% for their own peacemaking, 25% is used at the presbytery level and 50% is forwarded to GA for the Presbyterian Mission Agency to advocate for peace and justice in cultures of violence, including our own, through collaborative projects of education and Christian witness. **(October 6, 2024)**

Christmas Joy Offering (Season of Advent) celebrates the wondrous gift of Jesus Christ, our Savior. These gifts provide assistance to current and retired church workers in their time of need and developing our future leaders at Presbyterian-related racial ethnic schools and colleges. **(December 22, 2024)**

Other special gifts are the:

Presbyterian Hunger Fund supports the Presbyterian Hunger Program.

Theological Education Fund (1% Plan) supports seminaries and minister education.

Presbyterian Disaster Assistance enables compassionate response to emergency needs.
